

**St. Clair County 4-H King & Queen Application
2012-2013**

- 1) Applications are due no later than March 1, 2012 to the 4-H office, 200 Grand River Avenue, Suite 102, Port Huron, Michigan 48060.
- 2) Applicants must be between the ages of 15-19 years of age. Age determined as of January 1 of the current year.
- 3) Applicants must send a personal photo, suitable for enlargement and publication. Recommendation is a school photograph.
- 4) A selection committee will choose up to three female and three male applicants to serve on the 4-H Court, based on applications submitted. Applicants chosen for the court will be notified no later than the 2nd Saturday of March.
- 5) The court will be interviewed by a committee at Spring Achievement. 4-H King and Queen will be announced at the Awards Program of Spring Achievement. Court members must be present at Spring Achievement for an interview and for the awards program. Court members are encouraged to dress in appropriate attire for their interview, as well as for the awards program. Floor-length dresses are discouraged.
- 6) 4-H Court reign will be from Spring Achievement to Spring Achievement. The 4-H Court is strongly encouraged to participate in as many 4-H activities throughout their reign as possible, such as workshops, Council Auction, Leaders' Banquet, parades, Fair and Spring Achievement at the conclusion of their reign, as well as make public appearances and conduct radio interviews as requested. The 4-H Court is to be a positive role model and display appropriate behavior that represents 4-H at all times.
